AFL Cairns Inc adopts the Laws of Australian Football, the AFL & AFL Queensland policies, and the AFL Queensland State Junior Football Rules and Regulations. Where "local rules and regulations" to supersede the AFL Queensland State Junior Football Rules and Regulations apply, these will be known as By-Laws and included as an appendices to the AFL Queensland State Junior Football Rules and Regulations.

4. CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

4.3. These clubs shall include the clubs of Centrals Trinity Beach, North Cairns Tigers, South Cairns Cutters, Cairns City Lions, Cairns Hawks, Port Douglas Crocs, Pyramid Power, Cairns Saints and Cape York Eagles and any other Australian Football Club which may be accepted as a member of the league in accordance with this constitution.

10. MEMBERSHIP OF COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT

10.1 The Committee of Management shall consist of the following voting and non voting members:

14. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS

- 14.24 To be eligible to vote at the League's Annual General Meeting, all accounts of a league club, to 30 September of the current financial year, must be paid by 4:00pm on the day of the Annual General Meeting. A club may be eligible to vote if a structured repayment arrangement has been agreed with the Committee of Management.
 - (i) Signatories to club accounts must not be in a relationship that potentially compromises the security of club funds. Club account signatories must be submitted to the league each year.
- 14.25 Clubs who have outstanding invoices at the start of the season will not receive their football allocation until all payments have been received. Should the amount remain outstanding for more than one month into the season the league have the right to deduct points from the club.
